

HOME ACCESSIBILITY PROGRAM (HAP)

DO YOU OR SOMEONE LIVING IN YOUR HOME NEED A RAMP OR STAIRLIFT? HOW ABOUT AN ACCESSIBLE BATHROOM WITH A WALK-IN SHOWER?

SENIOR CITIZENS AND PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES MAY QUALIFY FOR ASSISTANCE FROM THE STATE OF ILLINOIS TO IMPROVE THE ACCESSIBILITY AND SAFETY OF THEIR HOME.



HAP FAQ

1. What kind of work can be done to the home?

Any modifications or repairs can be done to the home that make it more accessible for a senior with limited mobility or disabled person to live in the home. Most common projects consist of: walk in showers, stair lifts, platform lifts, & ramps.

2. Is this a gift?

This is a forgivable loan given in the form of a 5 year mortgage. Five years after the work is completed a forgiveness letter is sent to the participant releasing them of any liability of the loan.

3. Is this offered where I live?

Economic Growth Corporation sponsors applicants throughout Whiteside, Rock Island, Ogle, Jo Daviess, & Carroll Counties.

4. Do I need to own the home?

Renters may be eligible with landlord participation and agreement to forgivable loan terms.

5. How do I know if my home is eligible?

Single family homes, mobile homes on foundations, and condos (with association approval) are all eligible (restrictions may apply).

6. What are the requirements to be eligible?

Property taxes must be current. The home needs to be adequately insured. The home must not be in need of other major repairs/maintenance beyond the scope eligible under this program. Income restrictions listed below:
